

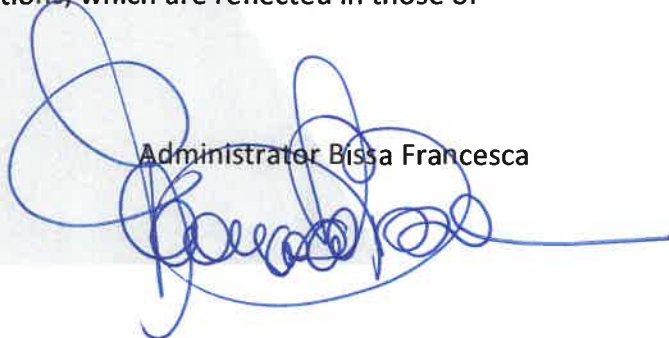
ENERGY EFFICIENCY POLICY

- Applies an Energy Efficiency Management System that complies with the requirements of ISO 50001, with the aim of continuously improving energy performance and the EnMS;
- Employ suitably trained, reliable and aware personnel who work safely every day in accordance with the policy promoted by the Company Management and disseminated at all levels;
- Supports the procurement of more energy-efficient products and services with the aim of achieving an increasingly positive impact on energy performance;
- Seeks the best technical, management and control solutions (Best Available Techniques, BAT) capable of ensuring a high level of environmental protection, as stated in European Directive 2010/75/EU and implemented in Legislative Decree 46/2014;
- Analyses, reviews and periodically updates its energy policy considering new goals or targets achieved;
- Plans and implements actions to address risks and opportunities, considering the context in which it operates, according to the Risk-Based Thinking approach;
- Relevant climate change issues have been assessed in our context factors and, consequently, for stakeholders, and have been reported in our risk analysis;
- Operates with qualified and constantly monitored external suppliers; they are considered partners and not mere suppliers of products and services, with whom we share our needs and expectations, which are reflected in those of our customers.
