

ENVIROMENTAL POLICY

Vibiplast S.r.l. is located in Parco Lombardo del Ticino - the first regional park in Italy. This park was established in 1974 to defend the river and the several natural environments of Ticino Valley from the attacks of industrialization and from a greater urbanization.

Therefore, we are more aware and motivated to manage our activities in a sustainable way, respecting the territory and focusing high attention on the environmental impact. Vibiplast believes that the adoption of an Environmental Management System brings real benefits to all stakeholders: to ourselves, to our customers, to our suppliers and to the entire community in which our organization operates.

To ensure this commitment, Vibiplast:

- Comply with environmental requirements as stipulated by the regulations in force;
- It is working to implement an ISO 14001-compliant Environmental Management System;
- We assess and monitor the company's Carbon Footprint calculation in accordance with ISO 14064 and have implemented the LCA (Life Cycle Assessment) calculation of our products in accordance with ISO 14040 and ISO 14044;
- Designed and developed a new and wide range of BIO-REC products, materials produced with BIO and BIO CIRCULAR polymers, ISCC PLUS certified.
- Designed and implemented ISO 9001 - ISCC PLUS certified Integrated Management System to guarantee the chain of custody of purchased BIO and BIO-CIRCULAR raw materials;
- Relevant issues related to climate change have been assessed in our contextual factors, and accordingly, for stakeholders, and this is reflected in our risk analysis;
- Constantly monitors, in a critical way, the production processes and considers the environmental impacts arising from them;
- Has implemented the use of renewable energy sources to the maximum extent possible;

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- Has reduced water consumption in its production processes to almost zero;
- Periodically check emissions into the atmosphere;
- Carries out periodic energy diagnostics and evaluates all opportunities that can lead to energy efficiency;
- It has an adequate waste sorting plan and is committed to managing waste in such a way as to privilege recovery and recycling, where possible, rather than disposal; to this end, it periodically verifies its waste by means of appropriate KPIs (Key Performance Indicators); Periodically assesses the waste cycle and adopts a proper plan for the separate waste collection;
- Systematically researches environmentally friendly raw materials, without giving up to our quality standards;
- Encourages employees to be responsible and aware in order to protect and preserve the environment.
